Q. What do you think of the current states of relations between Japan and India?







<u>Indians think Japan's contribution to the international community is commensurate with its economic strength.</u>






There is a relatively high interest in learning Japanese language among opinion leaders in India provided that there is an opportunity and facility available in their cities.
