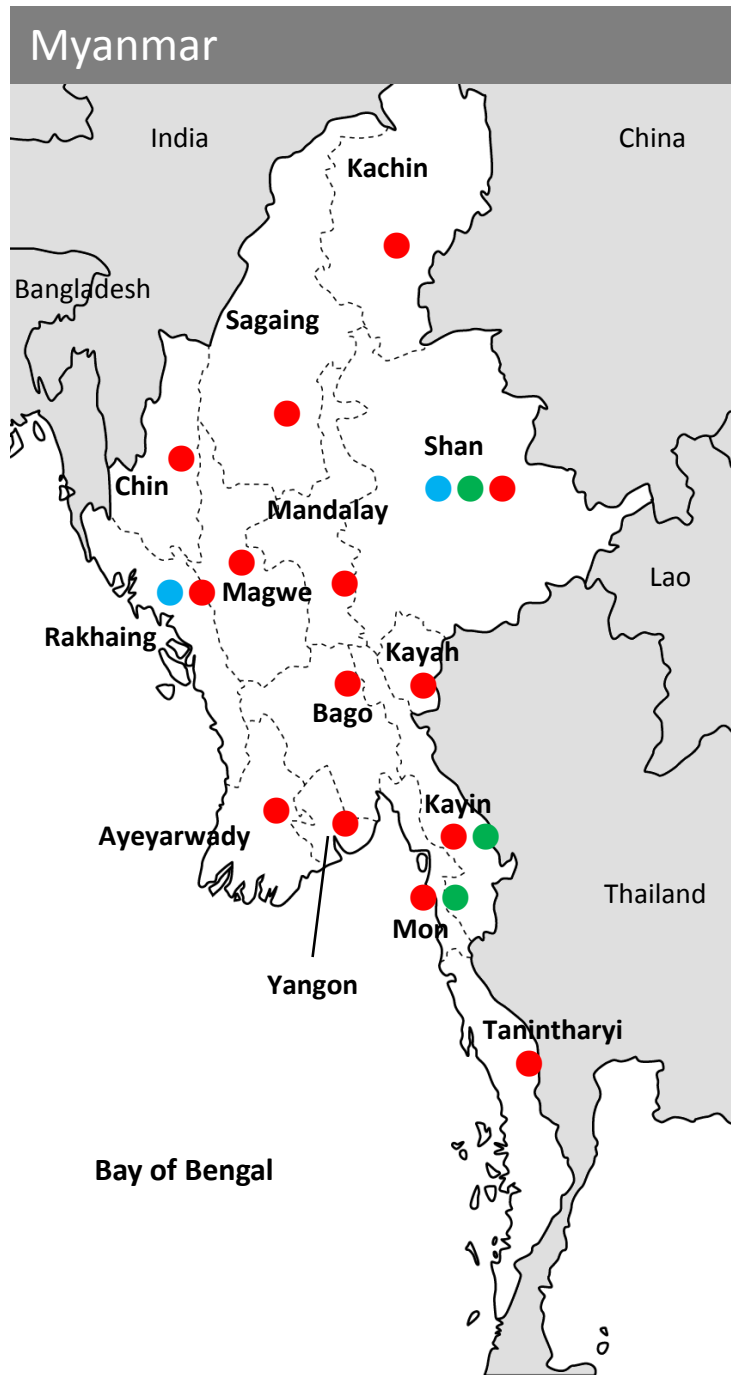

## Projects and Target areas

### ● EDUCATION

- In Shan State, “School construction” of 190 Schools (167 Elementary Schools, 10 Junior Schools, 13 High Schools) has completed.
- In Shan State and Rakhaing State, planning to construct another 200 schools all together within the next 5 years

### ● HEALTH

- Nationwide, “Traditional Medicine boxes” have been distributed to 7,000 remote villages. Planning to cover 28,000 villages by 2014
- In Kayin State and Mon State, planning to start “Mobile Clinic” project aimed at villagers living in remote areas
- In Kayin State, Mon State, and Shan State, planning to start “Distribution of prosthetic limbs” (for approx.6,000 persons/year, for 30,000 persons /5 years)

### ● AGRICULTURE

- In Kayin State, Mon State, and Shan State, planning to start Training for cultivation of medicinal plants and other crops for income generation
- In Shan State, micro-financing for agriculture and/or Training for agricultural improvement has been conducted in 190 villages. Planning to expand into 200 another villages in Shan State and Rakhaing State
