Your Excellency,

I have the honor to present to Your Excellency, at the instruction of my Government, the following requests for the consideration of the Department of State with regard to the recent revised dreft of the Japanese Feace Treaty.

1. <u>Hy Government requests that the word "renounces"</u> in Paragraph a, Article Number 2, should be <u>replaced by</u> <u>"confirms that it renounced on August 9, 1945, all right,</u> <u>title and claim to Korea and the islands which were part of</u> <u>Koree prior to its annexation by Japan, including the</u> islands Quelpart, Port Hamilton, Dagelet, Dokdo and Parangdo."

2. As to Paragraph a, Article Number 4, in the proposed Japanese Peace Treety, my Government wishes to point out that the provision in Paragraph A, Article 4, dose not affect the legal transfer of vested properties in Korza to the Republic of Korza through decision by the Supreme Commander of the Allied Forces in the Pacific following the defeat of Japan confirmed three years later in the Economic and Financial Agreement between the Republic of Korzs and the United States Kilitary Government in Korza, of September 11, 1948.

3. With reference to Article 9, my Government wishes to insert the following at the end of Article 9 of the proposed Feace Treaty, "Pending the conclusion of such agreements existing realities such as the MacArthur Line vill remain in effect."

Elease accept, Excellency, the renewed assurances of my highest consideration.
