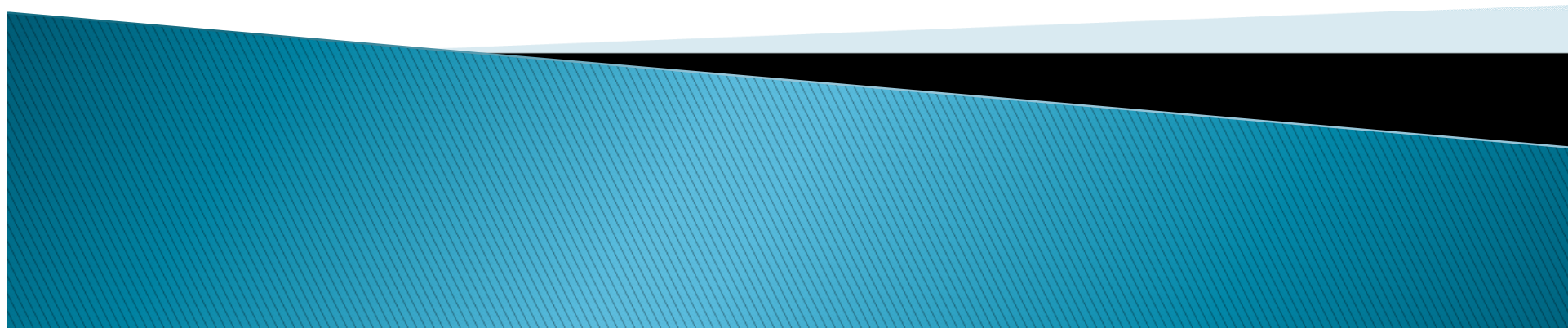

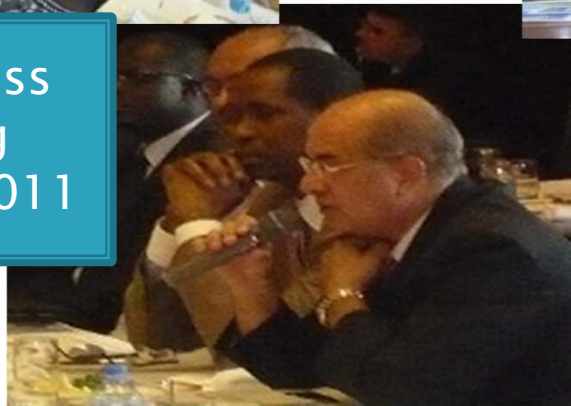

Having a surplus on 5th fiscal year.



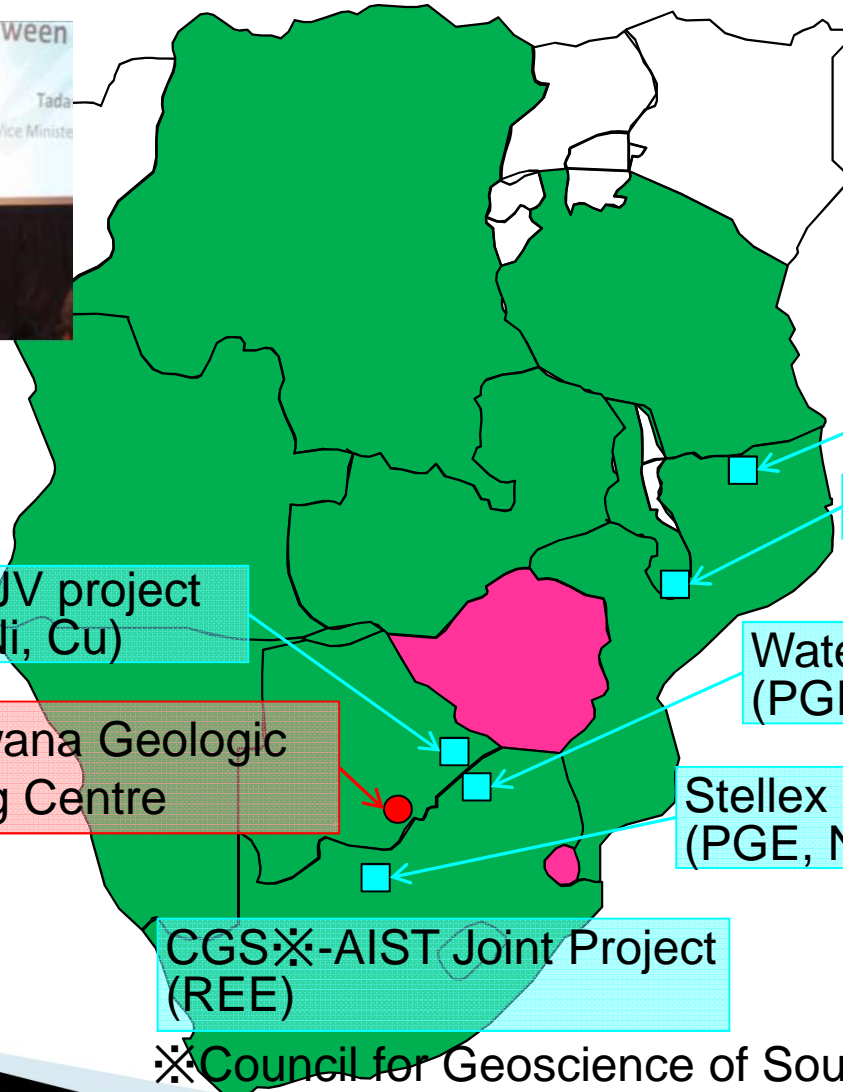
Advantages of Japan

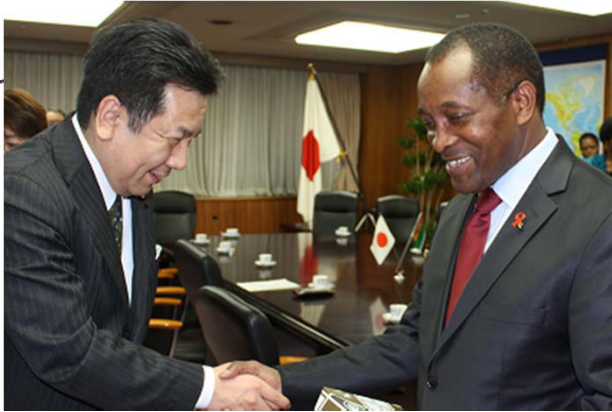
