
Japan's Current Status and Future Prospect of Economic Partnership Agreement (EPA)

II. Japan's efforts for EPA (bilateral & regional)

1. EPAs already concluded

Singapore	 The Agreement was signed by the two Leaders in January 2002, and entered into force on 30th November 2002. It was decided in April 2006 to start negotiations for a partial review of the EPA. The Protocol amending the Agreement was signed in March 2007, and the Japanese Diet approved it in June 2007.
Mexico	 The Agreement was signed by the two Leaders in September 2004, and entered into force on 1st April 2005. The Protocol related to improvement of market access conditions was signed in September 2006, and entered into force on 1st April 2007.

Malaysia	 The Agreement was signed by the two Leaders in December 2005, and entered into force on 13th July 2006.
Chile	 The Agreement was signed by Foreign Ministers of the two countries in March 2007, and entered into force on 3rd September 2007.
Thailand	 The Agreement was signed by the two Leaders in April 2007. The Japanese Diet approved the Agreement in June 2007. The Agreement is going to enter into force on 1st November 2007.
The Philippines	 The Agreement was signed by the two Leaders in September 2006. The Japanese Diet approved the Agreement in December 2006.
Brunei	 The negotiation on a bilateral EPA was launched in June 2006. The Agreement was signed by the two Leaders in June 2007.
Indonesia	 The negotiation on a bilateral EPA was launched in July 2005. The agreement was signed by the two Leaders in August 2007.

2. EPAs under negotiation or scheduled to be launched

ASEAN (as a whole)	 The negotiation was launched in April 2005. Japan and the ASEAN states have reached agreement in principle in August 2007. The 10th round of negotiations was held in October 2007.
GCC (Bahrain Oman, Qatar Saudi Arabia UAE, Kuwait)	 Japan and the GCC states decided to launch negotiations on an FTA covering trade in goods and services. The 2nd round of negotiations was held in January 2007.

Republic of Korea	 The negotiation on a bilateral EPA was launched in December 2003 The negotiation has stopped since November 2004.
Vietnam	 The negotiation on a bilateral EPA was launched in October 2006. The 5th round of negotiations was held in October 2007.
India	 The negotiation on a bilateral EPA was launched in January 2007. The 4th round of negotiation was held in September 2007.
Australia	 The two leaders decided to launch EPA negotiations in December 2006 The 2nd round of negotiations was held in August 2007.
Switzerland	 The two leaders decided to launch EPA negotiations in January 2007. The 3rd round of negotiations was held in October 2007.
