The High-level Panel on Global Sustainability (GSP) was established by the UN Secretary-General in August 2010 to formulate a new blueprint for sustainable development and low-carbon prosperity. The Panel's report, "Resilient People, Resilient Planet: A Future Worth Choosing", was launched on 30 January 2012. The Panel argues that by making transparent the cost of action and the cost of inaction, political processes can summon both the arguments and the political will necessary to act for a sustainable future. Its report contains 56 recommendations to put sustainable development into practice. Some of these recommendations can be instrumental in reassessing growth and decoupling it from resource use, achieving prosperity while reducing the use of fossil fuels.

This event provides an opportunity to present the GSP report, provide relevant inputs to the East Asia Summit process, and engage in a constructive dialogue, discussing options for implementation. Participants will also examine linkages between the recommendations in the GSP report with issues discussed in the East Asia Low Carbon Growth Partnership Dialogue and the Rio +20 process, such as:

- Standards and innovation, role of technology, energy efficiency and renewable energy;
- Green growth; and
- New ways to measure progress: shifting from quantity to quality of growth
