### **How is the Program Organized?**

YAP 2014 will be composed by three phases: **Training, On-site Visits and Dialogue/Debate/Role-Playing Discussion Sessions**.

$\hfill \square$ Training: Opening orientation and special lectures will be given on diplomatic practices,
international organizations and introductory knowledge about multilateral cooperation.
☐ On-site Visits: YAs will visit foreign ministries, embassies and other government agencies
and have face-to-face dialogues with policy-makers and great thinkers.
☐ <b>Dialogue/Debate/Role-Playing Discussion:</b> The open dialogue provides a platform for the
YAs to exchange ideas on trilateral cooperation in an open, candid manner. The debate helps
the YAs to find common ground over a series of issues that affect the relations among China
Japan and ROK. The role-playing discussion stimulates the YAs to have different way o
thinking while advocating in the position of other country. The overarching goal of designing
this comprehensive and creative format is to help the YAs to acquire better understanding o
other countries and further foster real sense of trilateral cooperation among young
generations.

Professional diplomats from the three countries and officers from TCS will serve the mentor for each team and give guidance for debate/role-playing discussion preparation.

☐ LANGUAGE: Be fluent in English. Additional language proficiency is highly preferred
☐ OTHERS: Have keen interests in Northeast Asian affairs. Be willing to build international
careers and work in multi-lateral environments

✓ Motivation to participate in the YAP and your interest to the TCS.
3. Certificate of the highest level of education
4. Optional - Official English standardized test scores (i.e. TOEIC, TOEFL, TEPS, etc.) and
Korean, Japanese or Chinese standardized test scores if applicable.
