

The Image of Japan in European Countries Interest in learning foreign languages




Question: Are you interested in learning foreign languages?

The Image of Japan in European Countries Interest in learning foreign languages Age groups, Gender and Education







The Image of Japan in European Countries Relationship between Japan and own country




Question: How do you think about the current state of relationship between your country and Japan? Is the relationship...?



Relationship between Japan and own country


Age groups, Gender and Education

The Image of Japan in European Countries Reliability of Japan as partner for own country



















The Image of Japan in European Countries Interest in international news




Question: Are you very interested, somewhat interested, not very interested or not at all interested in international news or information?



The Image of Japan in European Countries International news: Frequency of consumption




Frage: How often do you usually follow international news or acquire international information?
