I am most impressed by how serious Japanese is towards saving the Gaia. In the Omachi city, residents will travel to the recycling plant to dispose their recyclables. Before disposing those bottles, they will rinse to ensure the bottle was clean. They even do the sorting themselves inside the plant, which is contrast to what Singapore is practicing currently. Although some constituencies in Singapore organize the "earth hour" event which residents are encouraged to participate by switching off their electricity for that few hours, no one is really practicing do that before/after that event. In addition, some constituencies organize a monthly recycling program, but what really motivates residents to collect the recyclables are they are able to get some in return.. Without motivations, no one in Singapore really carries about that.
