■ <u>Achievements</u> Prof. Hiroshi Kobayashi, Professor, Tokyo University of Science, has developed a wearable exo-skeleton, or "muscle suit (Exo Muscle)," in order to assist workers in nursing care, factories, and other fields. He gave presentations about its development history and achievements, and demonstrated the suit at colleges and to health professionals.
