Chronology

- 1969 MNLF began fighting for independence
- 1984 MILF separated from MNLF
- 1990 ARMM Regional Government established
- 1996 Final Peace Agreement with MNLF
- 2001 Tripoli Agreement with MILF
- 2002 Support Package by Prime Minister Koizumi
- 2004 IMT established

2014

2006 Support Package by Foreign Minister Aso including IMT

Prime Minister Abe announced J-BIRD

- 2008 Failure MOA-AD (conflict intensified)
- 2009 ICG established, peace negotiation resumed
- 2011 Narita Meeting (President Aquino and MILF Chairman Murad)

Concept of Japan's Contribution

- Inclusiveness
 - >"One Mindanao" (including Muslim, IPs, Christian)
- Close collaboration on the ground
 International Staffs in Cotabato and Davao

[Japan's Support]

•Comprehensive approach even before the final peace agreement

- Socio-Economic Development (<u>J-BIRD</u>: Japan-Bangsamoro Initiative for Reconstruction and Development)
- Dispatch experts to International Monitoring Team (IMT)
- Participation to International Contact Group (ICG)
- Strong trust with both GPH/ ARMM and MILF/ BDA
- Capacity building for smooth transition towards establishment of new autonomous government
