- •All participants are expected to share proactively through SNS and other media about Japan's diplomatic stance as well as their experiences of charms of Japan, during / after the visit.

1. Purpose

- To expand better understanding of and greater support for Japan among young people.
- To develop over time a deep mutual-understanding and friendship between Japan and European countries.

- Participants: Graduate / Undergraduate students, young professionals
- Participating Countries: Countries in Europe, Central Asia and Caucasus region
- Duration: Around 10 days (Online Pre-exchange Program and Program in Japan)
- Number of Participants (JFY 2024): 85 (TBD)
- •Records: Started in 2015. After 2 year-long exclusively online exchanges and virtual visits due to the pandemic, travels resumed in 2022.

- Discussions with Japanese young students / experts at universities / think-tanks
- Homestay (in province)
