Sanjo City in **Niigata Prefecture**

ou can find beautiful scenery of paddy field across Japan. Especially, rice Terraces of Kitaimogawa is located at the foot of Mt. Awagatake, in Sanjo-shi, Niigata, paddy fields of this region are designated as one of "the 100 Best Terraced Paddy Fields of Japan" by the Ministry of Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries.

Landscape of the mountain village, created naturally and artificially, has a nostalgic feel.

You can enjoy the beautiful scenery of each season: fawn lily blooms against a background of Mt. Awagatake in spring, and in summer so does rosy lily, the official city flower of Sanjo. The paddy fields produce nationally renowned rice brand "Koshihikari".
