

# Summary of the Results of an Opinion Poll about Japan in Five Latin American and Caribbean Countries

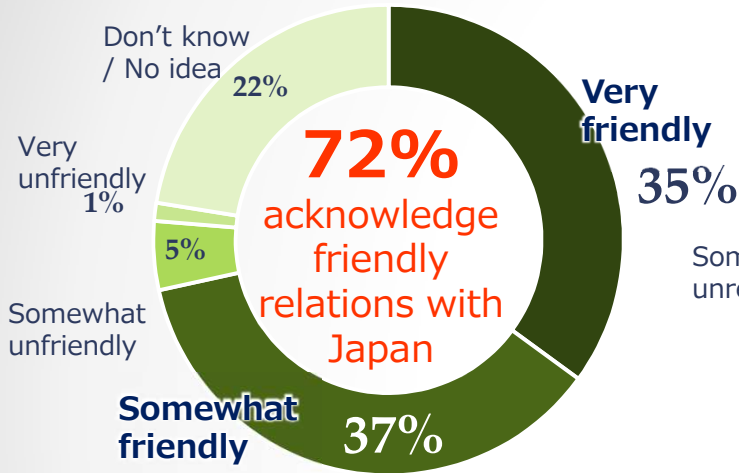
Countries Surveyed: Mexico, Brazil, Argentina, Colombia, Trinidad and Tobago

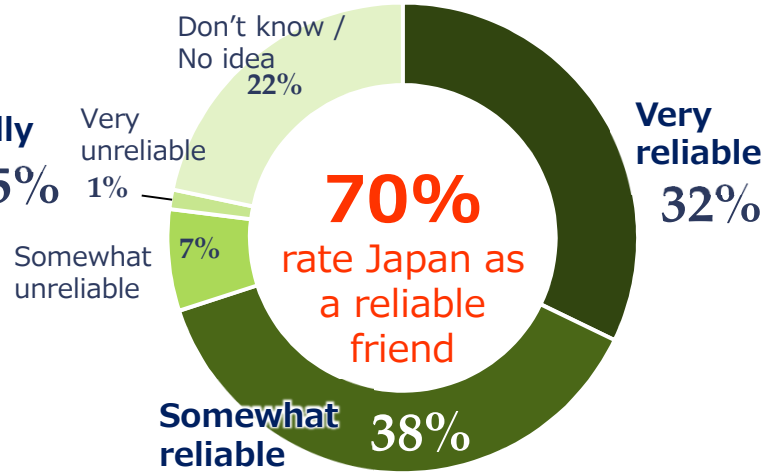
## I. Relations with Japan

Q. What do you think about the current state of relationship between your country and Japan?



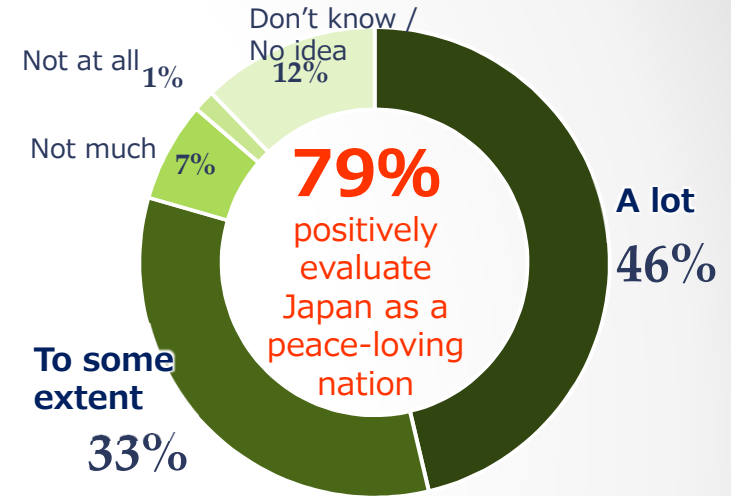
## II. Reliable Relationship

Q. How do you rate Japan as a reliable friend of your country?



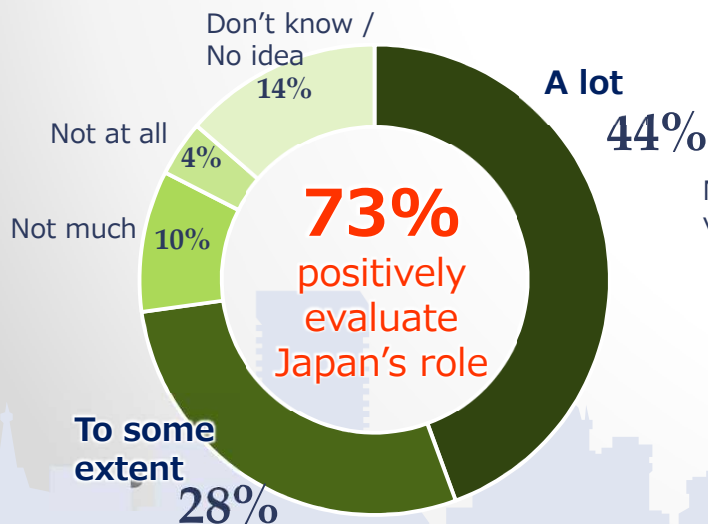
## III. Japan's Orientation as a Peace-Loving Nation

Q. How much do you value Japan as a Peace-Loving Nation for the past 70 years since the end of World War II?

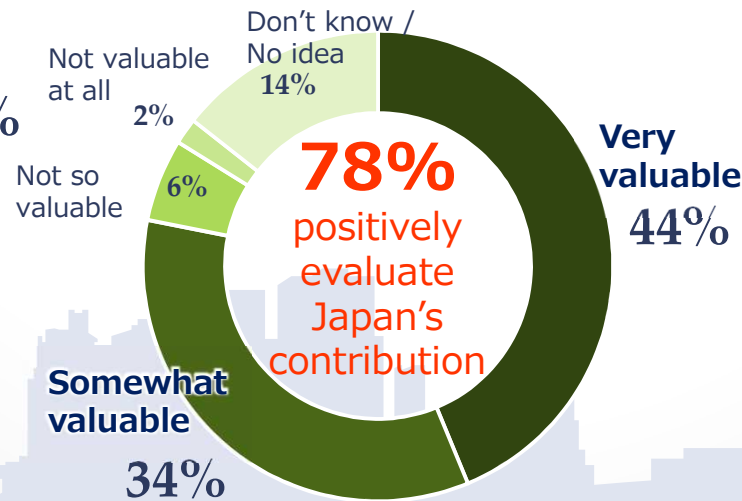


## IV. Role and Contribution of, and Expectation to Japan
