<u>1. Memorandum of Cooperation between the Japan External Trade Organization and the Invest in Canada</u>

- (1) Overview
 - The Japan External Trade Organization (JETRO) and the Invest in Canada (hereinafter referred to both Participants) work in close partnership toward broadening and deepening investment ties and stimulate business activities between both countries' private enterprises, focusing on promotion of innovation.

2. Memorandum of Understanding on Industrial Technology and Innovation Partnership between Advanced Telecommunications Research Institute International and the National Research Council Canada

- (1) Overview
 - Advanced Telecommunications Research Institute International (ATR) and the National Research Council Canada (NRC) (hereinafter referred to both Parties) establish a cooperation framework in the areas of industrial technology to promote bilateral R&D activities.
 - ATR declares that "Keihanna Research Complex Project¹" adopted by the Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology (MEXT) and the Japan Science and Technology Agency (JST) is a vital factor in starting the cooperation between both Parties.
 - ♦ Both Parties cooperate in the priority areas of the development of Robotics and Communication, focusing on applications of Neuroscience, Behavioural Science, and Wireless communication.
