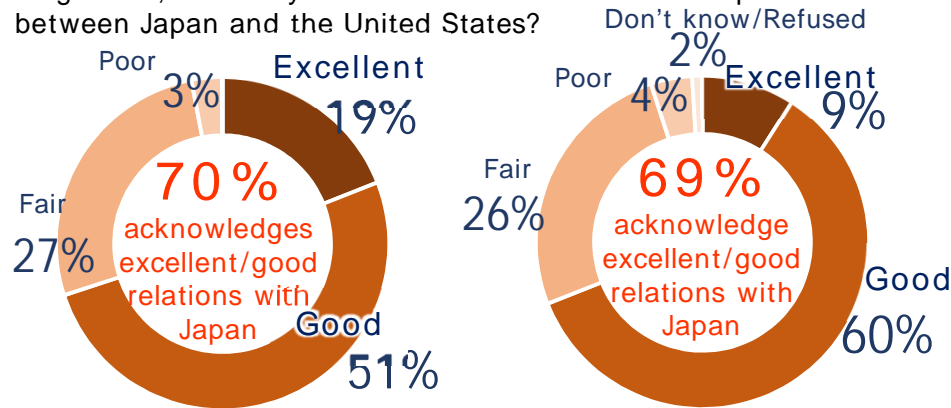

Q. In general, how do you view the current level of cooperation between Japan and the United States?

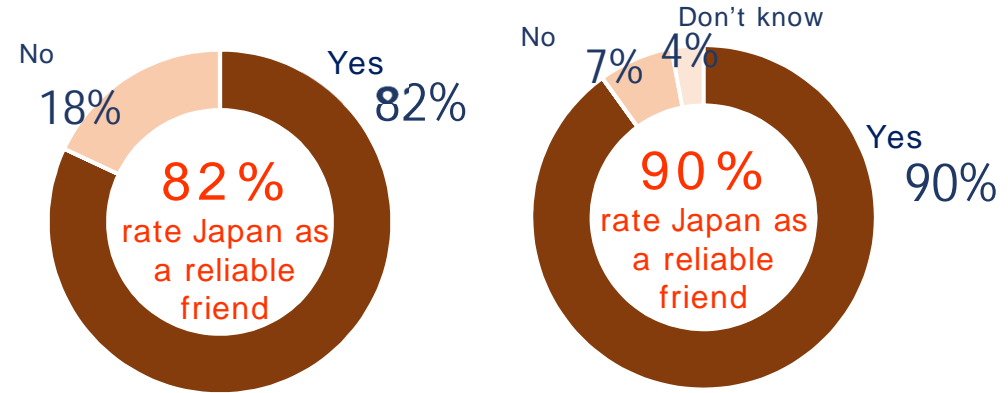

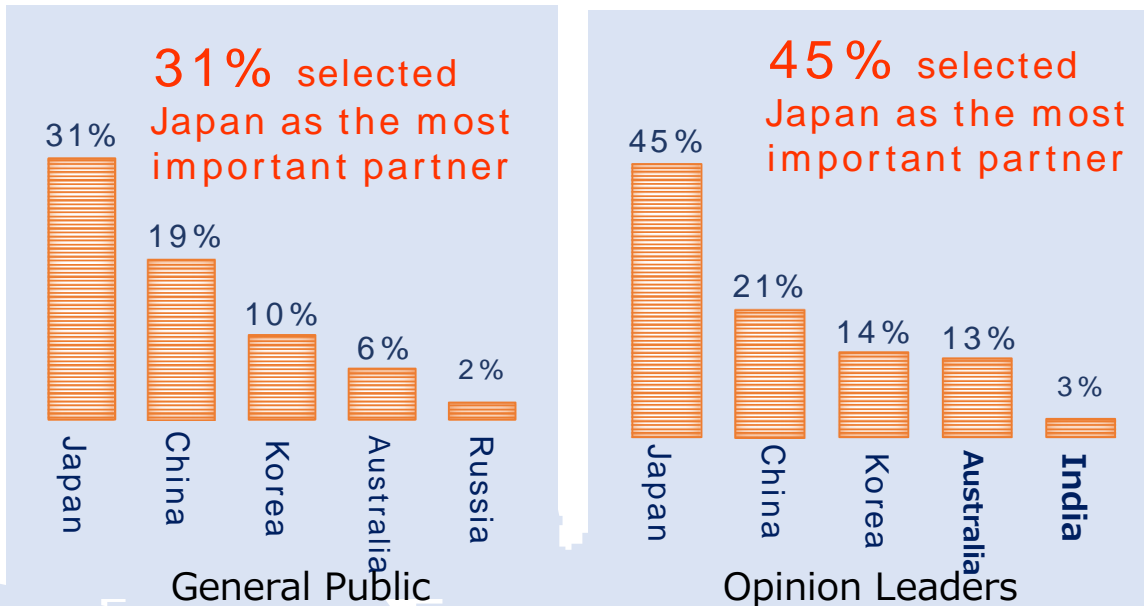
II. Reliable Relationship

Q. Which country in Asia do you think is the most important partner of the United States?

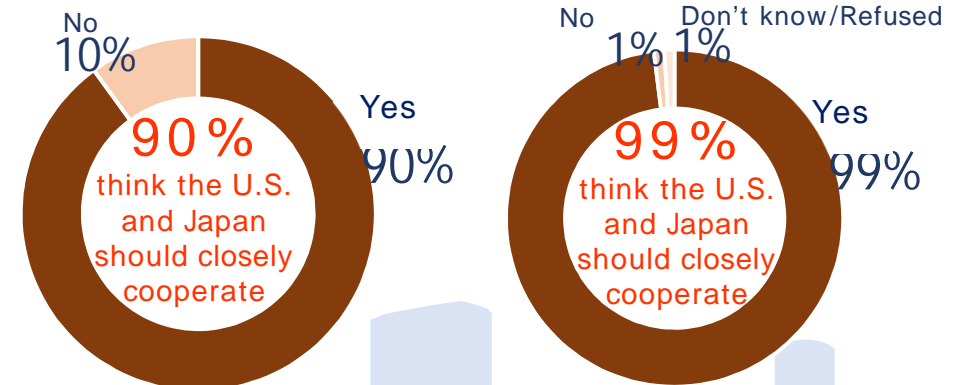
