

Visual Media Support Desk at the International Media Center (IMC) will provide overseas broadcasters with the following supports:

- Host Broadcaster (Movie) will record video and audio signals of the most of TICAD 7 sessions and official events by ENG. The overseas broadcasters can receive the recorded signals (MP4, Quick Time (QT) or Windows Media Player (WMP)) of necessary part of the session on a hard disk or an SD card, and perform necessary dubbing work with its own PC. The loan of recording media is free of charge, and on a first-come-first-served basis.
- The Desk will produce the signals in HD-SDI 1080i/59.94 with embedded audio (floor), 16:9.
- Limited facilities on video standards conversion will be available at the Desk. It will NOT provide tape to tape dubbing service, but the overseas broadcasters which bring their own recording equipment and video tape stocks, can perform dubbing work on a first-come, first-served basis, subject to availability. Please note that depending upon equipment you bring recording may not be possible.
- Working Space for IP Transmission will offer 24 wired LAN. The space comprises 32 seats on a first-come-first-served basis and each seat is expected to be furnished with a desk (shared by two seats), AC power sources (Type A electrical outlet, 100V) and a LAN port.
