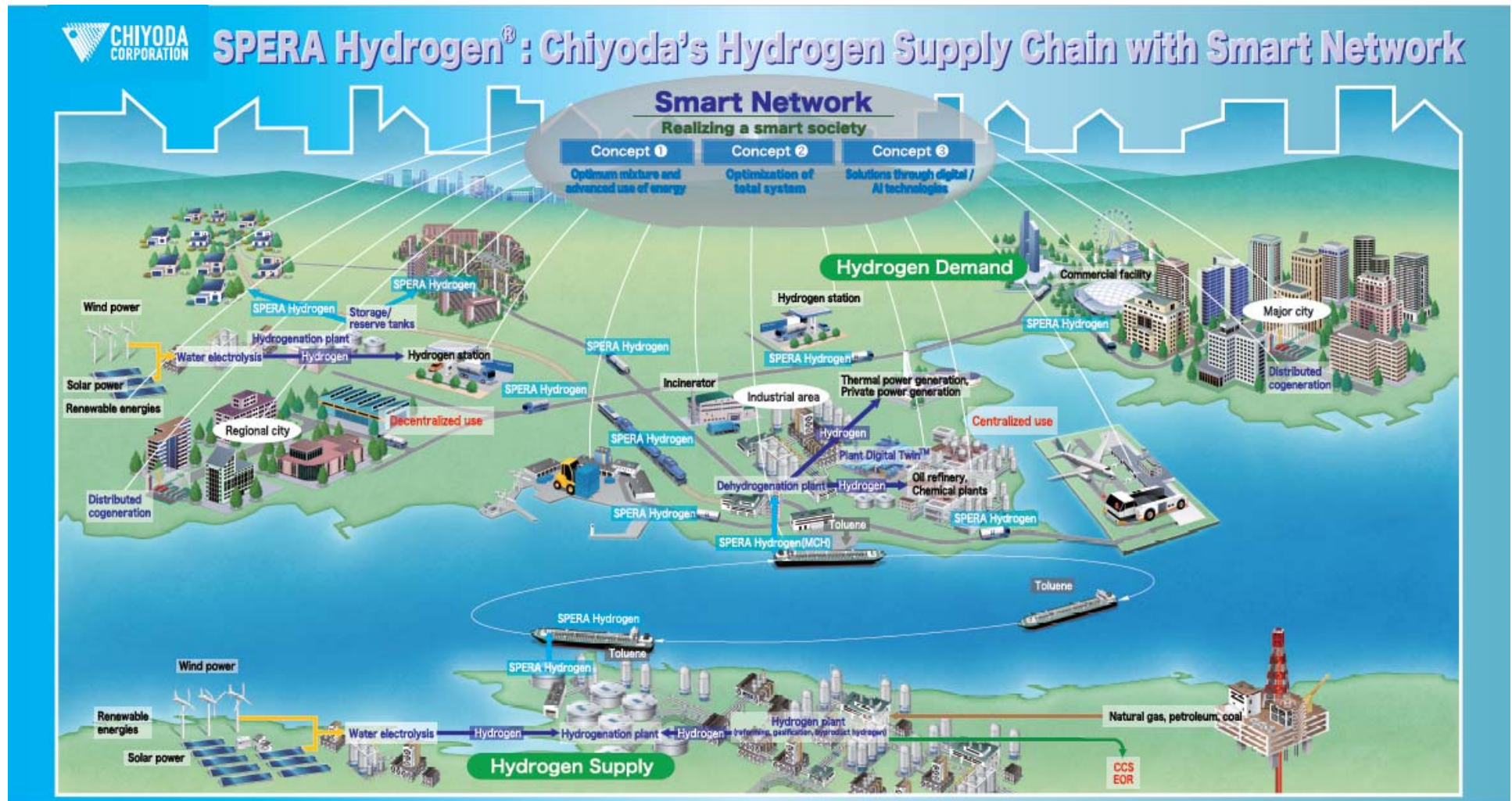

Needs for Infrastructure in Africa

- Infrastructure as base / fundamental
- Needs for various infrastructure
- Potential opportunities for cooperation by Japan

Expectations to Africa

- Infrastructure development as fundamentals for activity
- International cooperation for realizing potential projects
- Improvement of business environment

Contributions of Japan

■ Public financial aids

High quality infrastructure thru Japan's public financial aids including the program of NEXI (Nippon Export and Investment Insurance)

■ Infrastructure with the concept of “made with Japan”

High quality infrastructure with the technology transfer, human resource development and sophisticated technology and services together with the master plan, sound financial plan and O&M under the concept of “made with Japan”

■ Advanced technologies

Advanced technologies, such as renewable energy, smart grid, transportation system, water treatment, recycle and IT with reliable disaster-prevention / security

■ Japan Business Council for Africa and Bilateral Committee

Japan Business Council for Africa and Bilateral Business Promotion Committee for monitoring the progress of each project

■ Lifecycle cost for Japan quality

Evaluation based on the lifecycle cost of the infrastructures to value the quality, reliability and economics as well as on the human resource development and job opportunities thru resource development and technology transfer
