On October 18, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and the Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO) Liaison Office in Japan will co-organize World Food Day Symposium 2019"Creating a sustainable future -What can we do to reduce Food Loss and Waste?".

On October 16, the 'World Food Day' established by the UN as a day to reflect on global food issues, many events are held over the world with a view to achieving the SDGs Goal 2, 'Zero Hunger' by 2030. In Japan, the Food Loss Reduction Promotion Act has entered into force on October 1 this year. The food loss and waste reduction is one of the key issues on which Japan is making its efforts.

Against a background of momentum in the international community and in Japan, this symposium expects participation of about 100 people, including business people, government officials, academics and specialists from overseas.
