









III. Japan as a Peace-Loving Nation


Q. How much do you value Japan as a peace-loving nation for the past 70 years since the end of World War II?




To some extent, 33%

IV. Japan's Assistance & Relationship with Africa


Q. Do you expect more investments from Japanese companies to your country?
