# **Western Balkans Cooperation Initiative**

## MOFA of Japan

## 1. BACKGROUND

- The Western Balkan countries (WB: Serbia, Montenegro, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Albania, Kosovo, North Macedonia) promote domestic reforms and regional cooperation.
- Establishment of the <u>rule of law</u> and the <u>democracy</u> are necessary for EU membership.
- <u>Distrusts among ethnic groups remain</u> in the WB.

In January 2018, PM Abe announced "Western Balkans Cooperation Initiative" to support socio-economic reforms and facilitate

ethnic reconciliation of the WB.

Japan highly values the stability of the WB. We will promote cooperation with the WB through "Western Balkans Cooperation Initiative".

## 2. OBJECTIVES

- Supporting <u>socio-economic reforms</u> of the WB <u>toward EU accession</u>.
- Facilitating <u>ethnic reconciliation</u> by promoting cooperation in the WB.

# **3. CONCRETE MEASURES**

- (1) Bilateral Cooperation
- Promoting <u>high-level dialogue</u>.
- Designating <u>an Ambassador</u> in charge of the WB.
- Establishment of <u>new embassies</u>.
- Bilateral assistance through <u>ODA</u>.
- Promoting <u>Japanese companies' investment</u> to the WB.



#### (2) Promotion of Cooperation in the region (Japan-WB cooperation)

- Sharing <u>Japan's expertise</u> on the common challenges for the WB.
- Organizing seminars such as disaster prevention, SME promotion, environment protection.
- > Youth exchange program (for ethnic reconciliation), Capacity building for civil society.

#### (3) Cooperation with the third parties

- Implementing <u>collaborative support with EU countries</u> emphasizing WB's EU accession.
- Collaboration with "Berlin Process".
- > Collaborative support with Germany, Austria, Bulgaria, V4, Slovenia, Romania.
