JAPAN'S SUPPORT OF MORE THAN 250 MILLION USD TO EGYPT FOR THE FIGHT AGAINST COVID-19

“SAVE AS MANY LIVES AS POSSIBLE, AND LEAVE NO ONE'S HEALTH BEHIND”

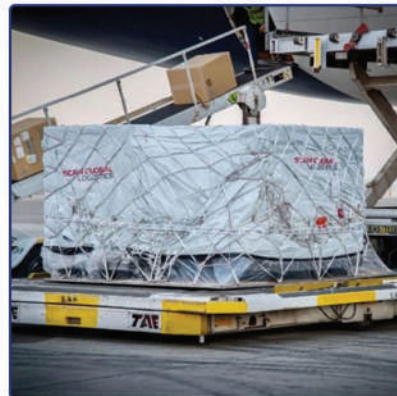
1. CONTRIBUTION VIA THE COVAX FACILITY

THE JAPANESE GOVERNMENT CO-HOSTED THE COVAX ADVANCED MARKET COMMITMENT (AMC) SUMMIT WITH GAVI IN JUNE 2021 AND COMMITTED TO CONTRIBUTING 1 BILLION USD TO THE COVAX FACILITY. THE SUMMIT RAISED WELL BEYOND THE TARGET OF 8.3 BILLION USD TO SECURE 1.8 BILLION VACCINE DOSES.

THE JAPANESE GOVERNMENT HAS PROVIDED 700,260 DOSES OF THE AstraZeneca VACCINE PRODUCED IN JAPAN TO EGYPT VIA THE COVAX FACILITY. THIS IS THE FIRST PROVISION OF VACCINES FROM JAPAN TO THE AFRICAN CONTINENT.



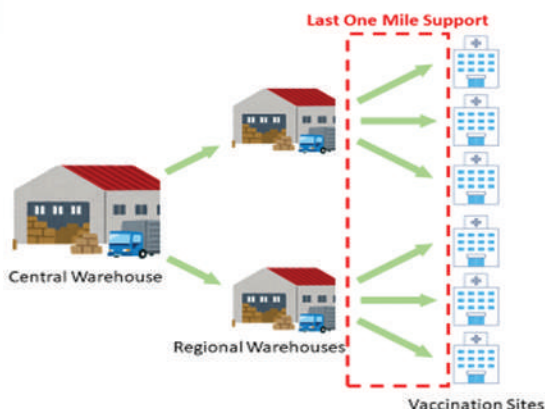

2. LAST ONE MILE SUPPORT FOR IMPROVING COLD CHAIN EQUIPMENT

THE JAPANESE GOVERNMENT HAS SUPPORTED THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A COLD CHAIN MECHANISM IN EGYPT THROUGH “LAST ONE MILE SUPPORT” TO ENSURE THE DELIVERY OF VACCINES TO EACH AND EVERY PERSON IN THE COUNTRY.

JAPAN HAS PROVIDED 5.3 MILLION USD THROUGH UNICEF TO PROVIDE 1,000 VACCINE CARRIERS, 1,100 ICE-LINED REFRIGERATORS, 1,250 VACCINE FREEZERS, AND 1,000 COLD BOXES AND DONATED 15 JAPANESE REFRIGERATED VEHICLES FOR VACCINES, THE FIRST VEHICLES IN THE WORLD THAT HAVE OBTAINED THE WHO'S “PERFORMANCE, QUALITY AND SAFETY (PQS)” PREQUALIFICATION.

3. PROVISION OF MEDICAL EQUIPMENT

THE JAPANESE GOVERNMENT HAS PROVIDED 9.3 MILLION USD FOR THE PROCUREMENT OF 13 CT SCANNERS AND 5 GENERATORS, ALL OF WHICH ARE MADE IN JAPAN, TO BE DISTRIBUTED TO CHEST AND FEVER HOSPITALS ACROSS EGYPT INCLUDING IN RURAL AREAS.

JAPAN PROVIDES 1.3 MILLION USD WORTH OF MEDICAL EQUIPMENT INCLUDING JAPANESE-MADE BRONCHOSCOPES AND ULTRASONIC DIAGNOSTIC IMAGING SYSTEMS TO HOSPITALS AT AIN SHAMS UNIVERSITY, FAIYUM UNIVERSITY, AND SUEZ CANAL UNIVERSITY.



4. EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE THROUGH INTERNATIONAL ORGANIZATIONS

THE JAPANESE GOVERNMENT HAS EXTENDED A TOTAL OF 6.8 MILLION USD TO EGYPT THROUGH INTERNATIONAL ORGANIZATIONS SUCH AS UNDP (2.73 MILLION USD FOR SUPPORTING MICRO, SMALL, AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES AFFECTED BY THE PANDEMIC) AND UNICEF (2.76 MILLION USD FOR PROTECTING THE VULNERABLE POPULATION INCLUDING WOMEN AND CHILDREN THROUGH INFECTION PREVENTION AND EDUCATION SUPPORT).



5. PROVISION OF PPE TO THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND POPULATION

JAPAN HAS PROVIDED 450,000 USD WORTH OF PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT (PPE) TO THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND POPULATION TO BE DISTRIBUTED TO COVID-19 ISOLATION HOSPITALS.



6. SUPPORTING COMMUNITIES WITH THE MINISTRY OF YOUTH AND SPORTS

JAPAN HAS PROVIDED A TOTAL OF 384,000 USD FOR AWARENESS CAMPAIGNS BY LOCAL YOUNG LEADERS FROM YOUTH CENTERS TO PROMOTE GARGLING AND WASHING HANDS ACTIVITIES AMONG YOUNG PEOPLE



7. SUPPORTING NURSERIES WITH THE MINISTRY OF SOCIAL SOLIDARITY

JAPAN HAS PROVIDED 120,000 USD FOR THE DISTRIBUTION OF VARIOUS EQUIPMENT INCLUDING PPE AND TRAINING FOR NURSERY FACILITATORS AT 300 NURSERIES.



8. E-JUST'S NEW RESEARCH PROJECTS IN RESPONSE TO COVID-19

JAPAN HAS PROVIDED 15,000 USD FOR 3 NEW RESEARCH PROJECTS AND ACTIVITIES AT E-JUST THAT AIM TO MITIGATE THE IMPACT OF COVID-19.



9. DEVELOPMENT POLICY LOAN FOR POWER SECTOR

THE JAPANESE GOVERNMENT HAS FINANCED EGYPT WITH 231 MILLION USD, AS JOINT FINANCE WITH AFDB AND AFD, TO PROMOTE THE EGYPT'S POWER SECTOR REFORM AS WELL AS GREEN GROWTH AND TO REDUCE THE FISCAL GAP TO HELP ACCELERATE EGYPTIAN ECONOMIC RECOVERY FROM COVID-19.
