

Ms. KAJI Misako graduated from the University of Tokyo (BA in Economics) and joined the Japanese Foreign Service in 1981. After graduated from Oxford University (MA in Philosophy, Politics and Economics), she served at the Japanese Embassies in the U.K. and in Vietnam, and the Japanese Missions to the EU and to the UN. She also served as Special Advisor to the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees (UNHCR), Deputy Press Secretary to the Prime Minister of Japan,



Professor at the Department of Advanced Social & International Studies of the University of Tokyo, Ambassador/Deputy Permanent Representative to the International Organisations in Geneva, Senior Research Fellow at the Institute for International Policy Studies, and Professor of International Relations at Hitotsubashi University. She was Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary to the Republic of Croatia (2019-2022). She was elected in 2021 at the UN General Assembly as member of the International Civil Service Commission (2022-25). In December 2022 she was appointed to be the Ambassador for Science and Technology Cooperation as Special Assistant to the Minister for Foreign Affairs of Japan.
