n November 30, 2022, Matsudo City concluded a Partnership Agreement with Constanza City, Dominican Republic. The Signing Ceremony was held online. This is the first occasion to establish the agreement between cities of the two countries. Matsudo City intends to ensure that each exchange between the two countries will develop steadily and their cooperation will expand more in the future.

sitama City in Saitama Prefecture held "Saitama Sustainable Cities Summit ~E-KIZUNA Global Summit~" in the city on November 22 to 24 last year, with the aim of contributing to the realization of a decarbonized society through mutual cooperation with cities in and outside Japan.
