



JOINT STATEMENT ON THE RESUMPTION OF THE NEGOTIATIONS ON THE FREE TRADE AGREEMENT BETWEEN JAPAN AND THE GULF COOPERATION COUNCIL

16 July, 2023

Reaffirming the vital importance of close cooperation between Japan and the Gulf Cooperation Council for strengthening economic ties between the two sides;

Desiring to further liberalize trade and investment between Japan and the Gulf Cooperation Council in a mutually beneficial manner;

Acknowledging that the Free Trade Agreement between Japan and the Gulf Cooperation Council (JGFTA) will provide the valuable foundations for expanding trade and investment and achieving greater cooperation between the two sides;

Following the discussion on the resumption of the JGFTA negotiations between H.E. KISHIDA Fumio, Prime Minister of Japan and H.E. Jasem Mohamed Albudaiwi, Secretary General of the Gulf Cooperation Council, on 16 July 2023;

Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of Japan to the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia and the Chief Negotiator for the Gulf Cooperation Council, have confirmed the following recognition;

- 1. Japan and the GCC concurred on resuming the JGFTA negotiations, and hold the next round in 2024.
- 2. Japan and the GCC will continue their efforts on discussions and internal process for the resumption of the JGFTA negotiations.
