

This project is being implemented with a system of 10 people. We receive demands from companies and hold extensive 3hour training sessions face-to-face or online.





Services available in 21 languages

Daily work is being carried out by 45 employees from 11 countries.


Each month, we handle about 7000 demands (by phone, email, or the GTN app) on various subjects and we maintain a high rate of successful treatment of more than 97%.

*Challenge: While an increasing number of foreigners is being received in Japanese society, the important question is to know to which level multilingual mechanisms can be implemented, especially in city offices, hospitals, and schools.

To facilitate communication in the above places, we carry out tripartite interpretation via phone or videoconference.
