Application procedures for Multiple Visa for Nationals of the Philippines for individual with considerable financial capacity

The following is an outline of application procedures for nationals of the Philippines with considerable financial capacity who wish to apply for a multiple entry visa (period of stay: 90 days, validity: 5 years). It is not permitted to perform activities to undertake revenue generating business operations or activities to receive remuneration.

1. Eligibility

- (1) Individual with considerable financial capacity
- (2) Spouse/child of the individual mentioned in (1) above

2. Required documents

Additional documents may be required on a case-by-case basis during the screening process.

(1) Individual with considerable financial capacity

- a. Passport (ordinary, e-passport in compliance with ICAO standard only)
- b. Visa application form (with photo)
- c. Certificate of employment (indicating period of employment, salary and position)
- d. Documents proving applicant's financial capacity (e.g. bank statement (for the last 6 months), certificate of national pension, tax payment certificate)
- e. (If applying from outside the Philippines,) documents to prove applicant's lawful residence

(2) Spouse/child of the individual mentioned in (1)

- a. Passport (ordinary, passport in compliance with ICAO standard only)
- b. Visa application form (with photo)
- c. Documents to prove kinship with the individual mentioned in (1) (e.g. marriage certificate, birth certificate)
- d. A copy of the passport and multiple-entry visa of the individual mentioned in (1) or documents mentioned in (1) d.
- e. (If applying from outside the Philippines,) documents to prove applicant's lawful residence

【Notes】

• Single-entry visa may be issued as a result of examination. For further details, please contact the Diplomatic Missions of Japan.
