

Japan's Comprehensive Package of Assistance for Humanitarian Mine Action

1 Three pillars

- Japan will provide a comprehensive package of assistance to humanitarian mine action for its various needs and stages (mine risk education, landmine clearance, and victim assistance), in collaboration with various partners, such as international organizations, NGOs, and Japanese companies.

2 Three approaches

(1) Triangular cooperation with Cambodia as a hub

- Japan will work with Cambodia as a hub to assistance to third countries affected by mine contamination in promoting knowledge-sharing and training by utilizing accumulated expertise based on past experiences of cooperation for mine actions.

(2) Cooperation on mine action with like-minded countries and International Organizations

- Japan will strengthen cooperation on mine action with like-minded countries and international organizations and advance more effective and efficient mine action, taking advantage of opportunities such as international conferences on mine action in Ukraine.

(3) Utilization of Japan's science and technology

- Japan will utilize science and technology developed by Japanese companies, such as mine detectors and mine-predicting AI technology.
