



## **Overview of Japan-China-ROK Cooperation**

- 1999 On the occasion of the ASEAN+3 Summit, a breakfast meeting among the leaders of the three countries was held at the suggestion of Prime Minister Obuchi.
  - = the first Japan-China-ROK Meeting among the three leaders.
- 2007 The first standalone Trilateral Foreign Ministers' Meeting was held.
- 2008 The first standalone Trilateral Summit was held.
- "Trilateral Cooperation Secretariat" was established in Seoul, ROK. 2011
- 2020 A special Foreign Ministers' Meeting on COVID-19 (online) was held.
- 2024 The 9th Summit was held (for the first time in about four and a half years).
- The 11th Foreign Ministers' Meeting was held 2025
