Since 2005, MOFA and IOM have held a series of international forum to introduce good practices and challenges in initiatives to deepen understanding of the issues regarding integration and inclusion of foreign nationals into Japanese society, and the 20th forum will be held under the theme of "Domestic and International Partnership among Municipalities toward Realizing Integration and Inclusion of Foreign Nationals in the Society.

As of June 2024, the number of foreign residents in Japan reached a record high of approximately 3.59 million, and their nationalities and activities are becoming more diverse. In Japan, where the society is facing declining birth rates and an aging population, foreign residents are expected to contribute to enhanced vitality and development of local communities by taking advantage of their diverse backgrounds.

We hope that this forum will serve as an opportunity for all of us to reflect on the importance of collaboration and partnership not only among domestic but also with overseas municipalities, sharing best practices and lessons learned, and deepening mutual understanding towards the realization of an intercultural society.
