Minister Akazawa's Telephone Talk with Secretary Lutnick

- 1. On June 28, commencing at 10 a.m. local time (11 p.m. JST), for approximately 15 minutes, and commencing at 7 p.m. local time (June 29, 8 a.m. JST), for approximately 20 minutes, Mr. AKAZAWA Ryosei, Minister in charge of Economic Revitalization of Japan, held a telephone talk with the Honorable Howard Lutnick, Secretary of Commerce of the United States of America, during his visit to Washington D.C.
- 2. Following their consultation held on the previous day, both sides reaffirmed their respective positions on the series of tariff measures by the United States and engaged in a fruitful discussion on expanding trade between the two countries, non-tariff measures, and cooperation on economic security, among others.
- 3. Both sides will continue to vigorously coordinate to realize a mutually beneficial agreement.
