# Strengthening the Global Supply Chain through Nacala Corridor Development (Co-creation for common agenda initiative)

**Development Goals**: Improve and strengthen transportation infrastructure and promote industrial development in the Nacala Corridor region (Mozambique, Malawi and Zambia) so as to increase the value of the Nacala Corridor as a transportation route for mineral resources and other goods through the enhancement of connectivity within the region. These efforts will lead to achieve sustainable development in the region through promoting investment and creating employment, and thereby strengthening Japan's global supply chains related to various resources.

**Development Scenario:** By improving and strengthening transport infrastructure in the Nacala Corridor, reinforce the global supply chain related to the corridor. By promoting industries such as mining and agriculture in the Nacala Corridor region, encourage economic growth and increase the added value of resources in the region. In this process, collaborate with various actors including Japanese companies and international organizations operating in Southern Africa, for maximizing the development impact.
