

Recognizing that **mine action is the zero stage for Ukraine's reconstruction**, it is essential for the entire international community to work together to strongly support and accelerate efforts that link mine action with reconstruction and socio-economic development. Building on the record of cooperation, **Japan will implement the Ukraine Mine Action Support based on three key pillars outlined below.**

1 Strengthening “Human Resource” and “Technology”

Promote capacity-building enhancement for domestic training facilities and related entities **serving as hubs for developing diverse personnel involved in mine action and enhancing their technical skills.**

e.g: ① Upgrading facilities and providing training equipment for the State Emergency Service of Ukraine (SESU) Training Center in Vinnytsia Oblast, Central Ukraine.

② Supplying demining machines and mine detectors, and conducting operational training to expand their effective use.

③ Collaborating with Ukrainian manufacturers in producing and maintaining specialized vehicles and demining machinery.

2 Ensuring Seamless Transition to Recovery and Reconstruction: “The Nexus”

➤ Promote support not only for mine detection and clearance, but also for **socio-economic revitalization**, including the safe rehabilitation of cleared land, the return of residents, and the promotion of industrial activities.

➤ Advance **medical, welfare, and social inclusion initiatives** including the prevention and mitigation of mine harm, **serving as a catalyst that bridges mine action with broader recovery processes.**

e.g: ① Comprehensive support for landmine victims, including medical care/welfare

② Education and awareness-raising programs to prevent mine-related risks.

③ A pilot project in Kharkiv Oblast, Eastern Ukraine, combining mine and unexploded ordnance clearance with regional reconstruction initiatives.

3 Diversifying and Strengthening Partnerships with Third Countries and International Organizations

Lead in diversifying and deepening the international network supporting Ukraine's mine action, through triangular cooperation with countries and institutions possessing relevant expertise and experience.

e.g: ① Signing of a Comprehensive MOC on Mine Action between Japan, Ukraine, and Colombia

Signing of a Memorandum of Cooperation on Mine Action between Japan and Ukraine

② Japan–Cambodia joint training programs for Ukrainian instructors and the development of new equipment adaptable to demining operations in Ukraine.

③ Financial contributions to mine action projects through the NATO Comprehensive Assistance Package (CAP) Trust Fund.
