1. According to the Public Procurement Act, 2006, entities having financial and administrative authority to procure goods, works and services with public fund is called Procuring Entity. Procuring Entities covered by the Public Procurement Act, 2006 and the Public Procurement Rules, 2025 include all Ministries, Divisions, their internal subdivisions, independent organs, attached departments, attached organizations, autonomous bodies, semi-government organizations and constitutional organizations. The subcategories under each Procuring Entity are internal subdivisions, that conduct their own procurement independently.
2. Chapter 11 covers public procurement carried out using public fund.
3. Chapter 11 does not cover contracts to be awarded following the guidelines of development partners.

4. Chapter 11 does not cover contracts to be awarded to co-operatives or associations in accordance with the laws and regulations existing at the time of entry into force of this Agreement.

5. Public procurement in Bangladesh is a decentralized process. Each Procuring Entity carries out its procurement activities independently following the Public Procurement Act, 2006, Public Procurement Rules, 2025, Bangladesh e-Government Procurement (e-GP) Guidelines (Revised), 2025 and Delegation of Financial Power.

- (b) Procurement which could lead to the disclosure of information incompatible with the purpose of the Treaty on the Non-Proliferation of Nuclear Weapons or with international agreements on intellectual property rights is not covered. Procurement for safety-related activities aiming at utilization and management of radioactive materials and responding to emergencies of nuclear installation is not covered for the following entities:
  - (i) Bangladesh Atomic Energy Commission (BAEC); and
  - (ii) Bangladesh Atomic Energy Regulatory Authority (BAERA).
- (c) Procurement related to geological and geophysical survey is not covered for the following entities:

Section 7  
General Notes

3. The term “physical services” means:
  - (a) materials and ingredients required to facilitate supply of goods or execution of works, or operation and maintenance of facilities or plants or surveys or exploratory drilling;
  - (b) security services, catering services, geological service or third-party services under stand-alone service contracts;
  - (c) selection of pre-shipment inspection (PSI) agent, clearing and forwarding agent, transportation of goods, hiring transport, selection of transport contractor for transportation of goods or insurance risk; or
  - (d) any services specified in this Part or specified by gazette notification, procured by the procuring entity by outsourcing.
4. The term “services” means related services, physical services, or intellectual and professional services.

Section 9  
Threshold Adjustment Formula

1. The value of thresholds set out in Sections 1 through 3 shall be calculated and converted into Japanese yen in every even numbered year, based on an average value of yen in terms of SDR in the most recent two-year period starting on January 1 of the year before the preceding year and ending on December 31 of the preceding year.
  
2. Japan shall notify Bangladesh of such value of thresholds and the period of its validity upon entry into force of this Agreement and then notify every two years the value of newly calculated thresholds and the period of its validity one month prior to the date of expiry of the previous value of thresholds.
