

# ASEAN-Japan Co-Creation Initiative for Artificial Intelligence (AI)

On October 26, 2025, Japan proposed the launch of **ASEAN-Japan Co-Creation Initiative for Artificial Intelligence (AI)**, which aims at deepening ASEAN-Japan cooperation to **utilize safe, secure and trustworthy AI tailored to each country's needs to solve economic, social, and developmental challenges, while addressing concerns and risks associated with AI.**

- ◆ The initiative aims to **strengthen government-to-government and industry-academia collaboration** between ASEAN and Japan focusing on the following four pillars:

## **Pillar 1: Co-Creation of AI Solutions**

- (1) Establish a co-creation platform to solve social challenges
- (2) Promote problem-solving using JICA's private sector partnership projects

## **Pillar 2: Institutional Development and Governance**

- (1) Cooperate to formulate AI strategies and roadmaps, or legislative framework
- (2) Strengthen cooperation through the Hiroshima AI Process Friends Group

## **Pillar 3: Human Resource Development and Capacity Building**

- (1) Develop human resources and job matching related to AI development and adoption
- (2) Cooperate on AI security (including cybersecurity)

## **Pillar 4: Infrastructure Support**

- (1) Support research and development of AI models that accommodate local languages and cultures
- (2) Support to establish data integration platform
