



In light of the severe international situation and uncertainty in the global economy, the visit aims for Japan and India to **jointly realize growth, prosperity, and resilience**, and to make the region as a whole **"more resilient and prosperous together."** To this end, under the Japan-India Joint Vision for the Next Decade, the two sides concurred on further strengthening bilateral relations as a **Partnership of Strategic Convergence and Trust for Shared Growth, Prosperity and Resilience**, advancing **mutually complementary cooperation** centered on the following three priority areas.



① Deepening the Japan-India Strategic Cooperative Relationship in Light of the Current International Situation

- ◆ **Security and defense cooperation:** Advancing strategic coordination under the synergy between the updated FOIP and India's MAHASAGAR (Mutual And Holistic Advancement for Security and Growth Across Regions)—India's cooperation initiative for the Global South and the Indo-Pacific.
- ◆ **75th Anniversary of the Establishment of Diplomatic Relations between Japan and India (2027):** Promoting exchanges through commemorative events and partnerships between local governments.

Concrete Outcomes

<Security Cooperation>

- ① Convening of the **4th round of the Japan-India 2+2 Foreign and Defence Ministerial Meeting within this year**
- ② Expansion of cooperation centered on **maritime security**
 - **Enhanced training and exercises** in maritime areas including the Indian Ocean
 - **Satellite-based Maritime Domain Awareness**
 - **Naval maintenance, repair and overhaul** cooperation
- ③ **Defense equipment and technology cooperation**
 - Welcoming the review of the three principles on the transfer of defense equipment and technology, and advancing **defense equipment and technology cooperation** under the framework of "Make in India"
 - Broad agreement on a Technical Collaboration Agreement (TCA) among private companies for the transfer of the shipboard **Unified Complex Radio Antenna (UNICORN)**

<Realization of the Updated FOIP>

- ① Commitment to **realizing the "Industrial Value Chain" concept** connecting the Bay of Bengal and the North Eastern Region of India
- ② Cooperation toward the realization of the **FOIP Digital Corridor Initiative**
- ③ Cooperation towards an **early convening of the Japan-Australia-India-U.S. (Quad) Leaders' Meeting**
- ④ Preparations for Launch of the **Japan-India-Philippines Track 1.5 Policy Dialogue**

<People-to-People Exchanges and the 75th Anniversary of Japan-India Diplomatic Relations>

- ① Promotion of approximately 1,000 top-level Japan-India joint research projects through the **LOTUS Programme**
- ② **Commemorative events** including anime, youth exchanges, and sports
- ③ Promotion of **exchanges between local governments**, including **collaboration between Yamanashi Prefecture and Uttar Pradesh**



② Advancement of Japan-India Cooperation in the fields of Economic Security and Energy Security

- ◆ **Economic security:** Confirming the direction of cooperation on such matters as countering the weaponization of economic dependencies, maintenance of a fair and sound competitive environment, and building of resilient and trustworthy supply chains among like-minded countries, and advancing concrete cooperation in each field.
- ◆ **Energy security:** Advancing cooperation toward the diversification of energy sources and decarbonization.

Concrete Outcomes

<Economic Security>

- ① **Issuance of the Joint Declaration on Economic Security Cooperation:** Confirming the direction of concrete cooperation toward **strengthening supply chain resilience in the five key sectors**, and establishing a follow-up mechanism. Confirming progress on cooperation projects including data centers and submarine cables.
- ② Establishment of a **Track 1.5 Dialogue**
- ③ Signing of MoCs on **exploration of critical minerals, batteries, and pharmaceuticals**
 - **Critical minerals:** Promotion of technical cooperation and information exchange in the field of mineral exploration sharing of technical knowledge (JOGMEC-GSI)
 - **Batteries:** Cooperation on IP protection and regulatory responses; building of trustworthy supply chains
 - **Pharmaceuticals:** Information exchange on API supply chains, and promotion of joint R&D

<Energy Security>

- ① Commitment to **ensuring freedom of navigation and the uninterrupted flow of commerce**, including through the Strait of Hormuz
- ② Promotion of regional resilience through **POWERR Asia**
 - Establishment of a **dialogue framework** on crude oil and petroleum product **stockpiles**
 - Support for **India's membership to the IEA**
 - Advancing joint participation in **upstream oil and gas development** projects
 - Provision of financing by JBIC for power transmission projects
- ③ Cooperation for resource diversification, decarbonization, and rural revitalization
 - Launch of the **"Japan-India CBG Initiative"** to support India's **biogas plant establishment** target
 - Promotion of **green hydrogen and ammonia** production in India (announcement of private-sector investment projects)



③ Co-creation of Economic Growth for Japan and India through Investment and Innovation Collaboration

- ◆ Advancing cooperation through **investment by Japanese and Indian companies** and **innovation collaboration** in **advanced technology fields** including AI, with a view to realizing India's national goal of **"Viksit Bharat"** (Developed India) and Japan's **"strong economy."**

Concrete Outcomes

<Trade and Investment>

- ① **Progress of investment in India by private-sector companies**
 - **Investment decisions on the scale of 2 trillion yen** over the past year since **the 10 trillion yen investment target** was set
 - Participation of over **150** representatives from the Japanese business community, with the signing of **129 cooperation memoranda** to be highlighted
- ② Development of an industry-government-academia ecosystem to support Japanese companies' entry into India, promoting market entry by **SMEs and startups**
- ③ Advancing efforts to **improve India's business environment**, and commencing deliberations toward the review of the **Comprehensive Economic Partnership Agreement between Japan and the Republic of India (CEPA)**
- ④ Strengthening financial cooperation and payment linkages, including through local currency transactions

<Advanced Technology Cooperation>

- ① Issuance of the **"MoC on the Next-Generation Mobility Partnership (NGMP)"**
 - Launch of a private investment-led cooperation framework in six mobility-related fields, including **railways and automobiles**
 - Exploring human resource collaboration in the **shipbuilding** sector
- ② Issuance of the **"Japan-India Joint Statement on Cooperation in the Field of AI"**: Under the Japan-India AI Cooperation Initiative (JAI), identifying priority areas of cooperation and welcoming new public-private cooperation
- ③ Issuance of the **Japan-India MoC in the Field of AI**
- ④ **Digital infrastructure:** Advancing cooperation in data centers, submarine cables, APN, Open RAN, and 5G/6G



To be reflected in and released through outcome documents including the **Japan-India Annual Summit Joint Statement**, the **Japan-India Joint Declaration on Economic Security Cooperation**, and the **Japan-India Joint Statement on Cooperation in the Field of AI**.
