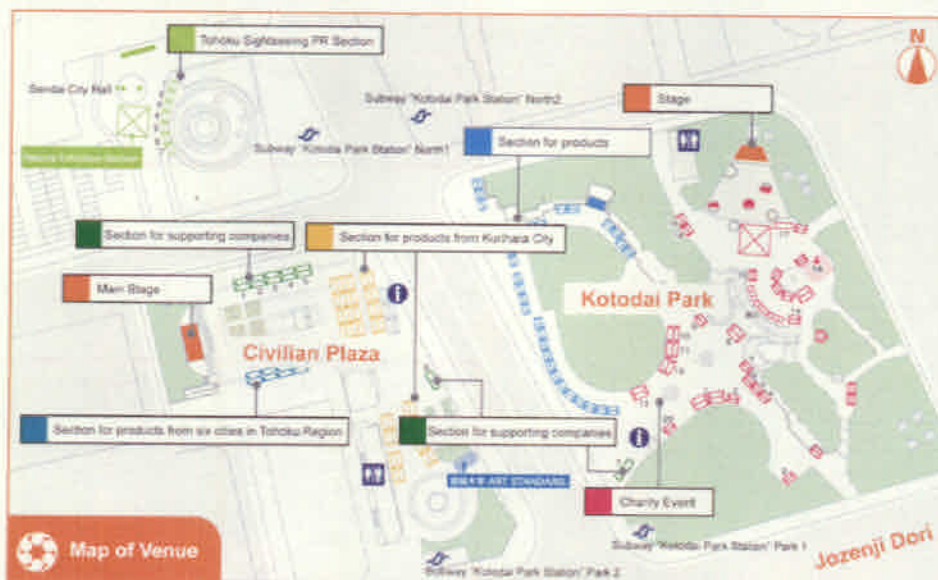
Outline of Event
