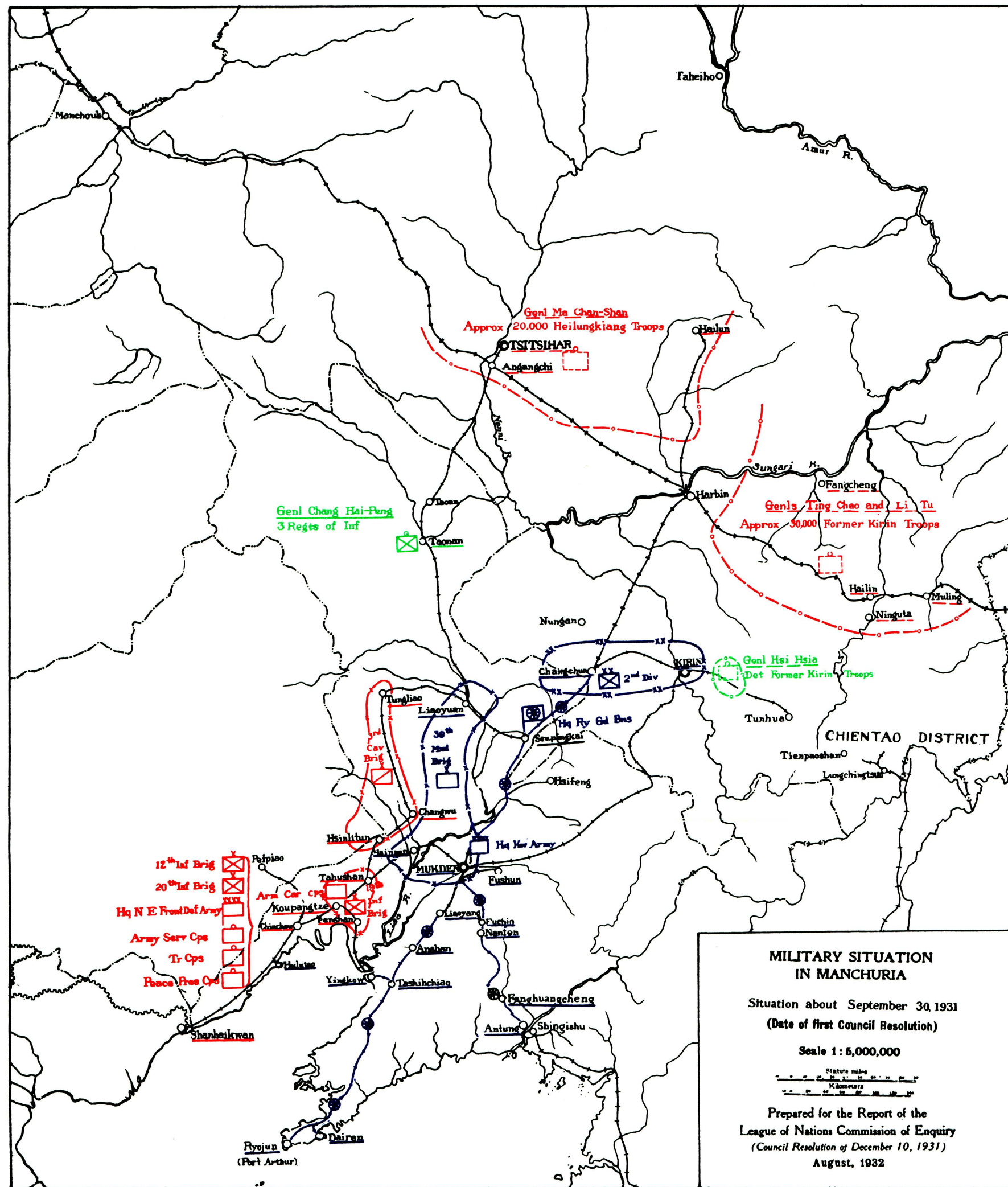


MAP No. 7.

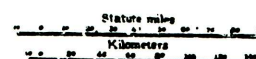
