



- SME co-operatives to reduce fixed costs for exporting
- Labour sharing to solve skills shortages and encourage knowledge transfer
- Utilize universities in FEALAC as sources of innovation & Research and Development
- Provide incentives (grants, tax credits) to enhance IT uptake, joint ventures and exporting
