#### (AIR SERVICES)

• Exchange of Notes on the New Schedule to the Agreement between Japan and the United Arab Emirates for Air Services

The Government of Japan and the Government of the UAE amended the Schedule to the Agreement to enable the designated airlines of both countries to operate new scheduled cargo flights on certain routes.

#### (BILATERAL CONSULTATIONS)

• <u>Memorandum of Cooperation on Improving the Work of A Joint Committee for</u> <u>Cooperation between the Government of Japan and the Government of the United Arab</u> <u>Emirates</u>

The Ministries of Foreign Affairs of the two countries decided to establish a Joint Committee chaired by the Foreign Ministers of the two countries to consult a wide range of issues including politics, economy, education and exchanges of personnel between the two countries.

#### (DEVELOPMENT ASSISTANCE)

 Memorandum of Cooperation between the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Japan and the Ministry of International Cooperation and Development of the United Arab Emirates for the Promotion of Cooperation and Understanding in the Implementation of International Development and Humanitarian Aid, in Areas and Matters of Mutual Interest

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Japan and the Ministry of International Cooperation and Development of the UAE decided to cooperate, consult and share information on matters related to international development and humanitarian aid and to work together in fields of education, health and disaster risk reduction toward the Millennium Development Goals.

#### (ENERGY)

• <u>Memorandum of Cooperation between the Ministry of Economy, Trade and Industry of</u> Japan and the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the United Arab Emirates on Cooperation in

### the Peaceful Uses of Nuclear Energy in the United Arab Emirates

The Ministry of Economy, Trade and Industry of Japan and the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the UAE decided to build a comprehensive framework to promote cooperation in the field of peaceful uses of nuclear energy, namely, in areas such as human capacity building, safety enhancement and emergency preparedness based on lessons learned from the Tokyo Electric Power Company's Fukushima Daiichi Nuclear Power Plant Accident.

## (ENVIRONMENT)

• <u>Memorandum of Understanding between the Japan Bank for International Cooperation</u> and Masdar for promoting information exchanges in the area of environment

The Japan Bank of International Cooperation (JBIC) and Masdar decided to build a framework for exchanging information to formulate projects in the field of environment in Abu Dhabi and other third countries.

### (BUSINESS, INVESTMENT AND SUPPORTS FOR ENTREPRENEUR)

• Agreement on the Extension and Amendment of Memorandum of Understanding between Small and Medium Enterprises and Regional Innovation, Japan and the Khalifa <u>Fund</u>

The Organization for Small and Medium Enterprises and Regional Innovation, Japan and the Khalifa Fund decided to expand the existing scope of cooperation including project for improvement of the status of women in the society, the preservation of handy craft technology and the promotion of entrepreneurship.

• Memorandum of Cooperation between Abu Dhabi Quality and Conformity Council and Japan Cooperation Center for the Middle East

The Japan Cooperation Center for the Middle East (JCCME) and the Abu Dhabi Quality and Conformity Council (QCC) decided to cooperate and exchange updated information relating to the missions conducted by the QCC in standardization, quality management, testing, metrology, and conformity schemes and assessment. The JCCME supports the QCC to establish cooperation with its counterparts in Japan.

• Memorandum of Cooperation between Abu Dhabi Chamber of Commerce and Industry and Japan Cooperation Center for the Middle East

The Japan Cooperation Center for the Middle East (JCCME) and the Abu Dhabi Chamber of Commerce and Industry (ADCCI) decided to exchange updated information regarding business and investment opportunities, to provide assistance for business mission and to facilitate business meetings to find potential partners.

#### (EDUCATION)

• Attachment to the Agreement on Academic Exchange between the University of Tokyo and the Petroleum Institute

The Tokyo University Graduate School and the Petroleum Institute decided to build a framework for a joint research and personnel exchanges in the area of energy, material and water cycle.

• Agreement for mutual cooperation in developing the solar car project between the Tokai University and the Petroleum Institute

The Tokai University and the Petroleum Institute decide to cooperate for the development of a solar powered vehicle and conclude technical confirmation relating to the production of solar car by students of the Petroleum Institute.
