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



The Object of the MEITI Process

Myanmar EITI Roadmap






EITI leads for open discussion for every step in production of extractive sector. And support for wide reform process.



Main Task of 3 Pillars in EITI Process




- ❖ Government and Companies' participation is an important role to disclose the Payment & Information.





- Mining law amended on 24.12.2015.
- Trying to issue the new mining regulations.
- Not comply with the international practice.

- Outstanding practice in Production Shearing Contract in Mining Sector.(Production Cost recovery)
- High Dead Rent(land rental fee) and other revenue rates.
