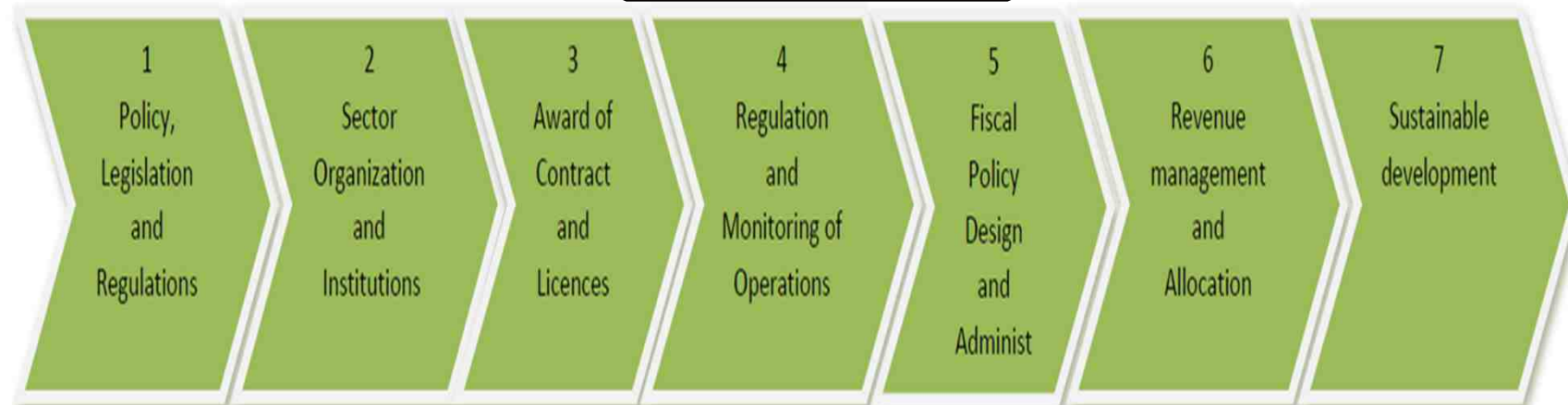

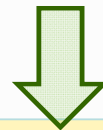

### Capacity deficits

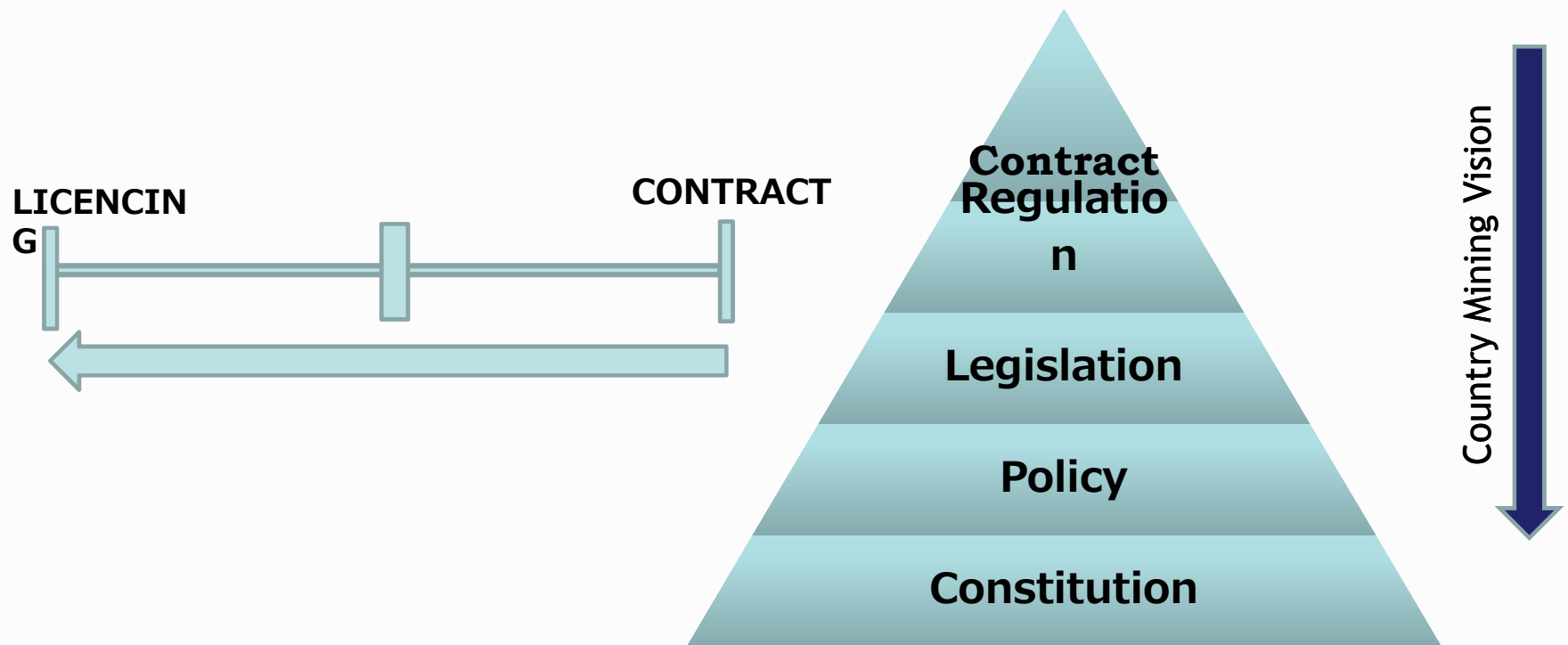


**Biggest asymmetries: Capacity gap between design and implementation - oversight / monitoring**

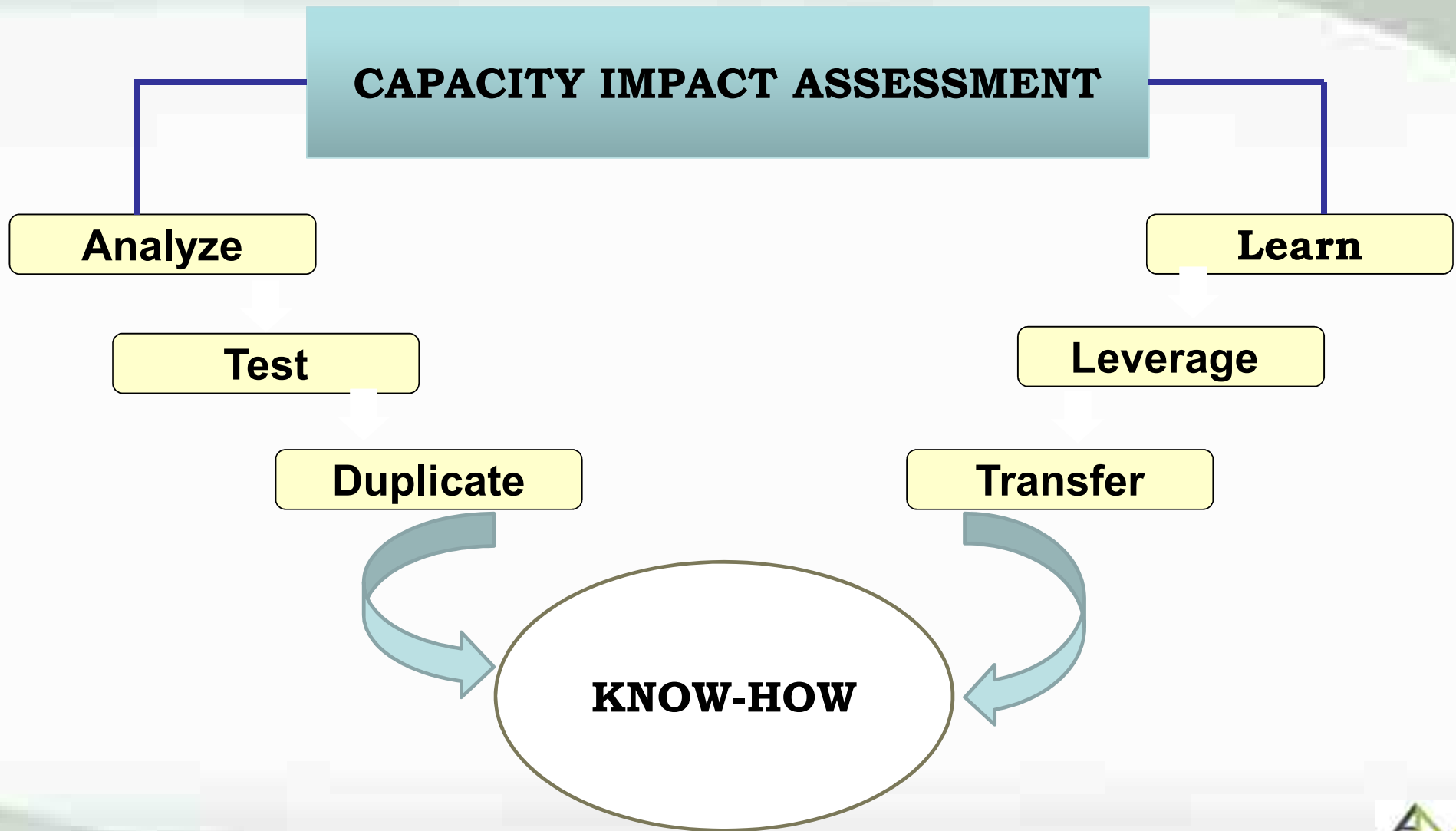
