

The Red Cross mouvement











The ICRC is an independent international organization, founded 1863 by Swiss business man Henry Dunant in Geneva, Switzerland, in memory of the organization's origins in the Battle of Solferino



The Mandate and Activities:

The ICRC is an independent, neutral organization ensuring humanitarian protection and assistance for victims of armed conflict and other situations of violence.

It takes action in response to emergencies and at the same time promotes respect for international humanitarian law and its implementation in national law.



Budget and figures 2017



- Presence in more than 86 countries around the world
- Annual budget: over 1.8 billion USD
- More than 17 000 staff worldwide
- Procurement of goods and services: over 600 M USD

Origin of funds

- Contributions from the States party to the Geneva Conventions (governments)
- National Red Cross and Red Crescent societies
- Supranational organizations (such as the European Commission)
- Public and private sources

All funding is voluntary
No tied Funds

Surgical Equipment: operating table, lamp and suction unit








Surgical instruments: external fixation, laparotomy, bone surgery sets

Laboratory equipment: blood analyser, HAEMOGLOBINOMETER HEMOCUE, CENTRIFUGE...










Procurement 2017: > 600 M USD




Procurement 2017 from Japan





General information

Used in regional intravenous anaesthetics or to limit blood loss in extremity surgery. Apply after emptying venous blood with an Esmach bandage; use sufficient pressure in the double air chamber otherwise it will cause blood congestion. Time limitation: 1 hour. Start and end times need to be recorded!

Tips for Japanese companies

- Only one interlocutor for all countries,
- CE-marked or FDA-approved goods,
- robust, easy-to-use, suitable for harsh conditions,
- documentation in English is compulsory, French is a "bonus",
- for complex machines (ex: x-ray units), possibility for installation/maintenance/training through web of local distributors,
- we try to avoid machines that come with short shelf-life consumables,
- we try to avoid machines that would require export licenses for shipping to countries under US embargo. That means we need to avoid as much as possible companies that are tied to US groups or that are using US-patented technologies,
- we usually have no interest (for now) in devices with online features like remote real-time monitoring, remote patient assessment, etc.

Japanese company: Success story



Do you know that more than 3 Billion people are at risk with malaria and they require Mosquito nets?

Japanese company: Success story

In 2001, Japanese Chemical company incorporated insecticide called pyrethroid into polyethylene fibers, to repel insects from factory windows!

The controlled release technology gradually brings the insecticide to the surface of the fibers.





The Chemical company thought it may be useful for people suffering from malaria. As a result of sustained R&D efforts, they developed an insecticidetreated mosquito net.

The net became the first net endorsed by the World Health Organization (WHO) in 2001 as a long-lasting insecticidal net, LLIN.



Through the United Nations Children's Fund (UNICEF) and other international organizations, the net is now supplied to over 80 countries.
