- Although the program will include insurance, the participant may apply for a separate insurance under the participant's expense, if desired.

Domestic Travel Insurance:

- The participant will be covered by insurance prepared by the program *during program period*. However, if the participant desires to apply for a separate insurance *before and after the program period*, it must be applied with the participant's own expense.
- The insurance applied by the program will cover the amount below at the most minimum:
 - Death/permanent disability insurance: 10 million JPY
 - Hospitalization insurance: 5 thousand JPY/day
 - Hospital visit insurance: 3 thousand JPY/day
