

JENESYS 2020 Japan-Lao PDR Online Exchange (Agriculture, Forestry and Fishing Village) Report

1. Program Overview

[Objective] This program was conducted with the main purpose of having Lao youth visit rural areas in Japan, inspect production sites, and interact with agricultural cooperatives as well as producers in processing businesses. The aim is to deepen their understanding of the advanced efforts and technologies of Japan.




