I won't forget how good their Japanese was, and how we had fun talking about our favorite anime.


Cooperating Organization

Hakodate Tour in Hokkaido, Japan


Hakodate is located in the south of Hokkaido and I would recommend this city to anyone traveling in Hokkaido.
