March 18, 2022

(Phnom Penh) On March 17, 2022, the Extraordinary Chambers in the Courts of Cambodia (ECCC) participated in a ZOOM meeting set up by the Japan International Cooperation Center (JICE) under coordination of the Embassy of Japan in Cambodia to share its work experience and educational dissemination on the judicial process in the ECCC with the National Peace Memorial Hall for the Atomic Bomb Victims in Nagasaki and the Legal Documentation Centre relating to the Extraordinary Chamber of Cambodia (LDC), and made the event available to the public.

This meeting provides new ideas for the ECCC and paves the way for open cooperation after the completion of the judicial process.

The speakers from the Nagasaki National Peace Memorial Hall for the Atomic Bomb Victims and the ECCC presented their work experiences, and talked about the establishment of the memorial hall, future prospects for the benefit of the victims, preservation of documentary evidence of the trial proceedings, and educational activities for the general public. These talks were conducted especially for the younger generation, so that they would understand the historical background of each court case and become more involved.
