



Is there any support for reducing this ratio?

Economic and other possible areas of cooperation</p> <p><b>Cyber Security</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Strengthening cyber security capabilities in the ASEAN region</li> <li>Training to enhance capacity to draft and implement cyber security policy in ASEAN</li> <li>Hand-on exercises such as Cyber Defense Exercise with Recurrence (CYDER) have been conducted for government organizations and critical infrastructure providers in the ASEAN-Japan Capacity Building Centre (AJCCBC) which opened in September 2019. 549 participants took online courses in 2021.</li> <li>Industrial control system (ICS) Cyber Security training to Indo-Pacific Region conducted jointly with the USA and the EU. Approximately 580 people participated in 2021.</li> </ul> <p><b>ASEAN Economic Resiliency</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Enhancing economic cooperation based on the ASEAN-Japan Economic Resilience Action Plan</li> <li>More than 50 projects have been proposed by both ASEAN and Japan under the ASEAN-Japan Economic Resilience Action Plan, which was adopted in July 2020, to mitigate the economic challenges brought by the COVID-19 pandemic and ensure long-term economic resilience for post-pandemic recovery.</li> <li>Under the Action Plan, projects such as strengthening supply chain resilience, providing financial support for Asia digital transformation, and promoting trade facilitation are making progress. ### ◆ Working Youth
