- **End extreme poverty:** Reduce the share of the global population that lives in extreme poverty to 3 percent by 2030.
- **Promote shared prosperity:** Increase the incomes of the poorest 40 percent of people in every country.


14th President of the World Bank Group since June 2, 2023.



**IDA**, World Bank's fund for the poorest, is one of the largest providers of funds to Sub-Saharan Africa. In FY2022, IDA's commitment reached a record high of **\$27.5 billion**.


## MIGA's role

- Engaged in providing political guarantees in emerging and developing economies, credit enhancement for countries and SOEs, guarantee to trade finance


## Sectors supported by MIGA and development outcomes (FY15-FY22)




## Africa

- Outstanding guarantee in FY2022: \$ **24.4 billion**
- SSA accounts for 27 percent, with the largest share (above \$ 6 billion)
- More than 100 active projects in over 30 countries in Africa  
(EEI/power and energy account for 60 percent of the portfolio)

## MIGA's Exposure in Africa Top 10 countries






# Percent of people living under poverty line (\$2.15/day)

(in percent of the total population)





# Adult literacy rate, 1993 and 2021




# Sub-Saharan Africa: breakdown of flow of funds

(ODA, OOF, private funds, and personal remittances)




# Low-income countries <sup>1/</sup>: debt sustainability analysis (jointly conducted by IMF and IDA/World Bank)
