



1. Dispatch of Japan Disaster Relief (JDR) Medical Team

- On March 31, Assessment Team was dispatched to Myanmar
- On April 2, JDR Medical Team was dispatched and arrived (32 members, including doctors and nurses)

2. Provision of Emergency Relief Goods

- On March 30, 240 water-proof sheets and 450 tents, stocked by Disaster Emergency Logistics System for ASEAN (DELSA), funded by Japan-ASEAN Integration Fund (JAIF), were delivered
- Decided to distribute essential goods (sanitary items, water, and water purifiers etc.) to the people affected by disasters through JICA

3. Emergency Grant

- On April 2, the Government of Japan announced that Japan is prepared to implement Emergency Grant of approximately 6 million US dollars through international organizations (the details will be coordinated with relevant international organizations)
